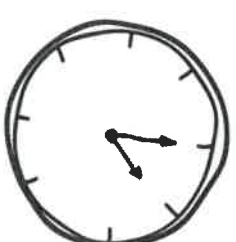

Arrive on time

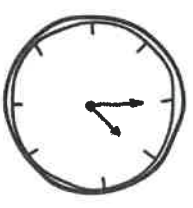
Be collected by their adult on time

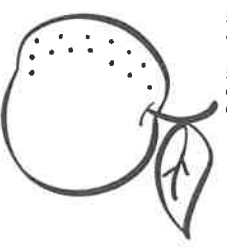
SNACK TIME

To encourage independence, children access the snack area in Reception. Children are required to choose a snack, pour a drink and clean away after themselves.

Children are not required to bring in any additional snacks. If you wish to send your child with an extra snack please send fruit or toast only.

Children are welcome to bring in a water bottle, but water is available in class at all times.

Magic Breakfast is available every morning in Reception.

Staff will support your child at lunch time. This could include opening items in their packed lunch, supporting the use of knives and forks and encouraging the children to eat their lunch. Staff will keep you updated on your child's progress over lunch.

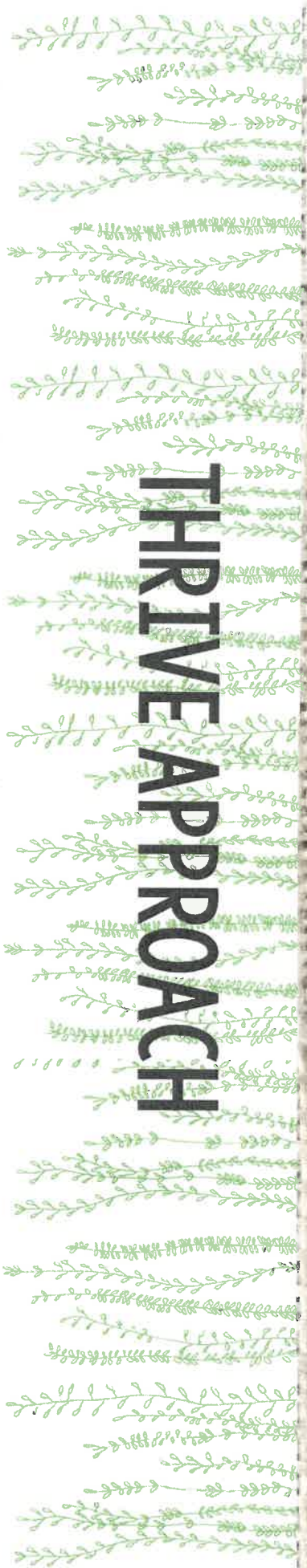

SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD IN PREPARATION FOR SEPTEMBER

- Can use the toilet independently.
- Can wash their hands independently after toileting and before eating (may need reminders).
- Can attempt to put on own coat and fasten it up.
- Can sit and listen well to a story.
- Able to follow a single step instruction given by an adult.
- Can talk in simple sentences to express their needs and wants.
- Can recognize and attempt to write their name.
- Can say and recognise numbers in their play.
